CLUB TRIALS & EVALUATION PERIOD

During the first week after arrival, participants begin trials with IFX partner clubs to be evaluated by both the IFX staff as well as by the partner clubs. Training schedules for participants during the evaluation period can not be provided in advance but participants will be notified by the IFX representative generally the day prior or in the morning/early afternoon about their training for that evening. Participants may undergo several weeks of trials before a club ultimately decides to offer a spot on their team. In most cases, participants are placed within 2-4 weeks with a club. In some cases, it can be much quicker, or a bit longer, but the average is 2-4 weeks.

IFX places participants with clubs that are a good fit for their level. This means that we strive to place them with a club that will provide them with a challenging training and playing environment in order for them to improve all aspects of their game. On the other hand, participants are not placed with clubs where the participant is over their head and not have a realistic chance of getting playing time, or becoming a disruption to the partner club's training.



COMPENSATION OF CLUBS

Should the club that offers the IFX participant a spot on their roster, also offer them financial remuneration, we will discuss their terms directly with the participant.

Participants who are intending to play in the NCAA or already play in the NCAA and plan to return, must be careful about the amount of remuneration received by a club. In general, the participant is permitted to receive no more than what could be considered as reimbursement for soccer related expenses such as travel to/from training.

For Amateur/Semi-pro teams, clubs between the 4th and 7th divisions normally pay their participants something. The amount ranges significantly depending upon many factors including the clubs own financial situation and the desire the club has for a particular participant.

IFX makes no guarantee that a participant will be paid or will be able to be placed with a club that pays their participants.

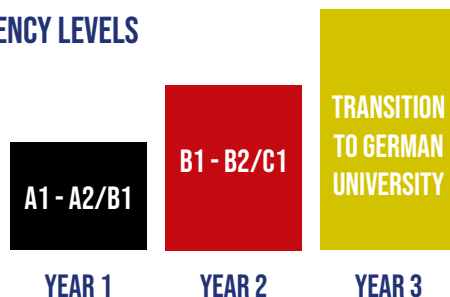
LANGUAGE SCHOOL

For the Pro IFX programs, participants study in an **intensive language program**, studying the native language of the country. Normally the classes take place 3-4 times per week in the morning or afternoon, generally about 3-5 hours per day. The language institutes are private organizations, generally with small class sizes located in downtown Nürnberg.

The language programs are **offered in different levels and terms**. A participant who has never studied the language before would start at the first level, and after the term, if successful in completing the course, would then move on to the next level for the next term.

Participation and attendance in the language school is an **integral aspect of the IFX program** and required. Learning a new language or improving in one already understood is a tremendous asset to have in one's future. It is also important to be able to communicate in the native language for daily life.

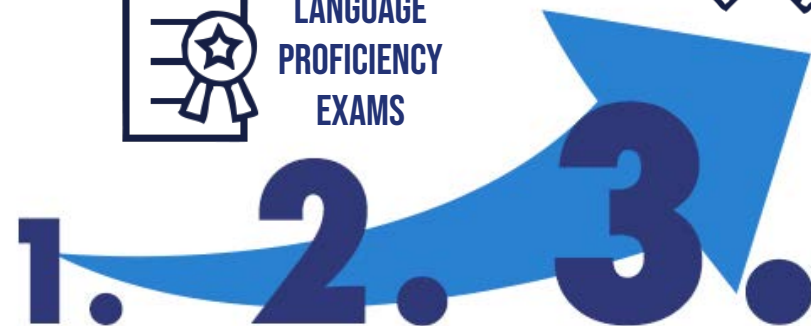

NÜRNBERG IN A NUTSHELL:

- LOCATED ON THE RIVER PEGNITZ AND ON THE RHINE-MAIN-DANUBE CANAL IN THE GERMAN STATE OF BAVARIA
- 170 KILOMETRES (NORTH OF MUNICH)
- THE SECOND-LARGEST CITY IN BAVARIA
- THE URBAN AREA ALSO INCLUDES FÜRTH, ERLANGEN AND SCHWABACH
- AS OF 2016 THE “EUROPEAN METROPOLITAN AREA NÜRNBERG” HAD APPROXIMATELY 3.5 MILLION INHABITANTS

What makes Nürnberg unique?

- Historical Significance: Nürnberg has a rich history dating back to the Middle Ages and was a significant center of the **Holy Roman Empire**, known for its imperial castle and role in the Imperial Diet.
- Medieval Old Town: The city boasts a beautifully preserved medieval old town, with half-timbered houses, cobblestone streets, and historic landmarks like the Church of Our Lady (**Frauenkirche**) and the Albrecht Dürer House.
- **Nürnberg Trials**: It was the site of the Nürnberg Trials, where Nazi officials were prosecuted for war crimes after World War II, making it an important location in modern history.

- Fürth has a rich Jewish history, with one of the oldest Jewish communities in Bavaria. **The Jewish Museum Franconia in Fürth** showcases this heritage and is housed in the former Jewish school building.
- Fürth is often referred to as the **"Green City"** due to its numerous parks, gardens, and green spaces. The city boasts well-maintained parks such as Stadtpark Fürth and Südstadtpark, providing residents and visitors with ample opportunities for recreation and relaxation.
- Fürth survived the Second World War with less damage than most German cities, and many historic buildings remain. **The Old Town** area, with its narrow streets and charming squares, is particularly noteworthy for its architectural beauty.

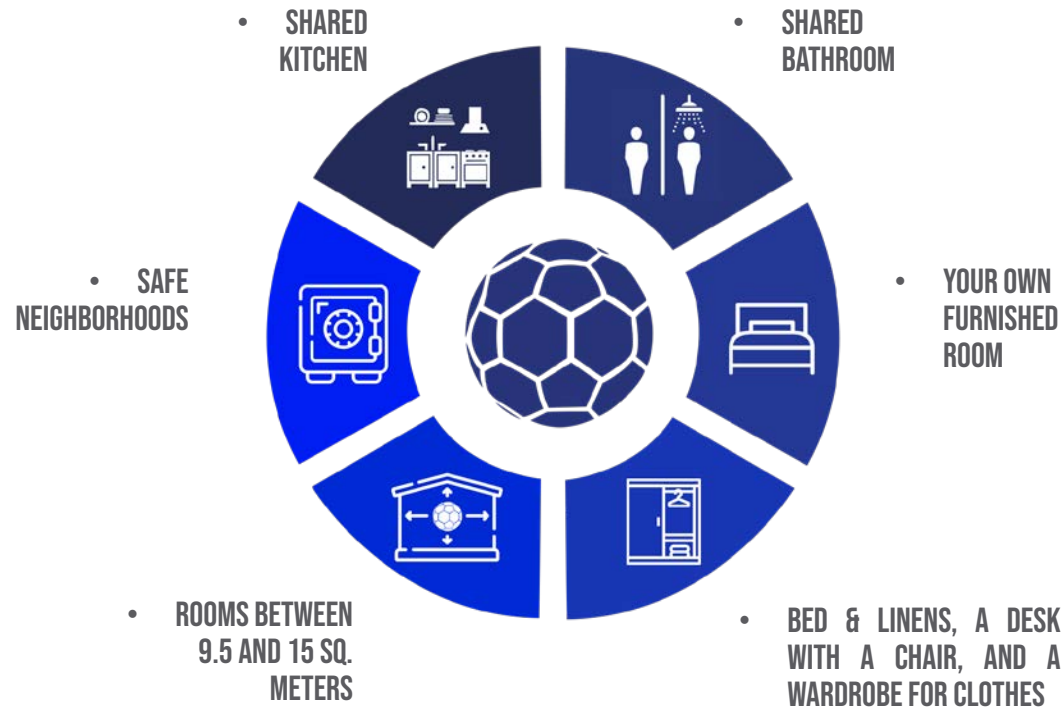

1. SC FEUCHT

BAYERNLIGA (5TH DIVISION)

Tucked aside a picturesque Bavarian forest, SC Feucht remains a close IFX partner club, and formidable Bavarian opponent competing in the tough Bayernliga Nord Division. Nearly a decade ago, Feucht once competed in the then German 3rd division, Regionalliga, and now remains one of the top German soccer clubs in the Nürnberg area. Feucht also fields strong youth teams generally competing in the Youth Landesliga or Bezirksoberliga.

SC ELTERS DORF

BAYERNLIGA (5TH DIVISION)



SC Eltersdorf is another top regional German soccer club, who competes in a very tough German division, the Bayernliga Nord. In 2013, they were narrowly relegated from the Regionalliga, but are in contention for promotion back into the top Bavarian league. Eltersdorf also fields a second team who competing in a mid-tier Amateur league. They are considered to be one of the top German soccer clubs of the Nürnberg region.



DJK GEBENBACH

BAYERNLIGA (5TH DIVISION)

DJK Gebenbach was founded in 1960 and after decades in district leagues the team began to take off, reaching the Landesliga in 2016 and celebrating promotion to the Bayernliga in its 2018, where it has remained as protagonist ever since. In the Bayernliga, DJK Gebenbach played as runner-up in the 2018/19 and 2022/23 season for promotion to the Bayern Football Regional League but they failed in the promotion relegation, the last time with 1:4 at home and 1:2 away at SpVgg Ansbach 09.

BAYERNLIGA (5TH DIVISION)

ASV Neumarkt, has long been one of the top Nürnberg regional clubs, currently fielding two squads, with their first team in the Bayernliga Nord division. Neumarkt has long been an official partner and feeder club of 1.FC Nürnberg, Nürnberg Bundesliga football club. IFX has had a number of players wear the Neumarkt jersey over the years including Tristan Watson, a professional striker from Toronto, Canada, Gabriel Padilla, Michael Sheridan, and most recently Charlie Ward (former San Jose Earthquakes Academy player)

TSV KORNBURG

BAYERNLIGA (5TH DIVISION)



Turn- und Sportverein Kornburg 1932 e.V. is a sports club from the Nuremberg district of Kornburg. In the summer of 2015, the team was promoted to the sixth-class Landesliga Bayern as champion of the Bezirksliga Mittelfranken. There, as runner-up behind ASV Neumarkt. In the following season, the club under coach Herbert Heidenreich became champion of the Landesliga and was directly promoted to the Bayernliga. Currently, the club is the most successful Nuremberg football team behind the 1st. FC Nürnberg and its second team.



Q SG QUELLE FÜRTH

LANDESLIGA (6TH DIVISION)

TV Fürth 1860 is the largest sports club in Fürth, to which their soccer department, SG Quelle Fürth belongs. Quelle has long been a respected club in the region, and is currently an official partner and feeder club to Bundesliga (major league) club SpVgg Greuther Fürth. In particular, Quelle is known for their strong youth soccer development, currently siding most of their youth teams in the 2nd highest German youth division, Youth Bayernliga or 3rd highest Youth Landesliga.

Canadian Teen Striker Christian Lamb signs for 2. Bundesliga SpVgg Greuther Fürth U17s in Winter Transfer

Initially seeking overseas experience, Lamb attended the **Youth Summer IFX Germany camp in Bayern**, impressing coaches and securing a spot with partner club **Soccer City / 1. FC Eichsfeld in the U17 Regionalliga Nordost**. Competing since August, Lamb's consistent strong performances attracted interest from Bundesliga clubs, leading to trials organized by IFX Soccer with clubs such as Energie Cottbus, Erzgebirge Aue, Chemnitzer FC, and SpVgg Greuther Fürth. Just before the January 31 transfer deadline, **2. Bundesliga club SpVgg Greuther Fürth** offered Lamb a place in their U17 team for the German Rückrunde (Spring season), with the potential to move up to their U19 team for the 2024-25 U19 Bundesliga campaign.



Californian teen Colin Davis transfers to German Regionalliga club Würzburger Kickers U19s

Colin Davis, a standout striker from the Bay Area, recently signed for Würzburger Kickers after a successful stint with 1. FC Eichsfeld U19s. Last summer, Davis underwent a **one-month training** opportunity with IFX Soccer in Nürnberg, impressing scouts and earning a spot with **1.FC Eichsfeld and Soccer City** for the Fall season. Davis showcased his talent by scoring 9 goals in 7 games for the U19s and 9 goals in 11 games for the semi-pro men's team. Trials organized by IFX and partners with Bundesliga clubs like Chemnitzer FC and Carl Zeiss Jena culminated in a deal with **Würzburger Kickers**. Davis, born in 2006, aims to make his mark in Würzburg's U19s, competing in the Bayernliga, the second-highest U19 German division. He faces competition from experienced striker Saliou Sané, who leads the squad with 12 goals.



Gonzalo López keeps climbing the ladder to play professional soccer in Germany

Gonzalo López Güereña, aiming to become a professional soccer player in Europe, moves closer to his goal by transitioning to a strong Regionalliga club in Germany's Bayern region after a season with FSV Zwickau's U19 team. His journey with IFX began in 2017-18 with the **Youth Year IFX program** near Dortmund, followed by stints at **SSV 07 Schlotheim** and **FSV Zwickau**, where he made significant progress. Despite being stranded in Mexico due to Covid in 2020-21, Gonzalo returned to Germany in July 2021 to pursue his academic and soccer ambitions. Since 2021, Gonzalo competed for Regionalliga club **TSV Rain am Lech**, and most recently for the Bayernliga Nord's **1. SC Feucht**.

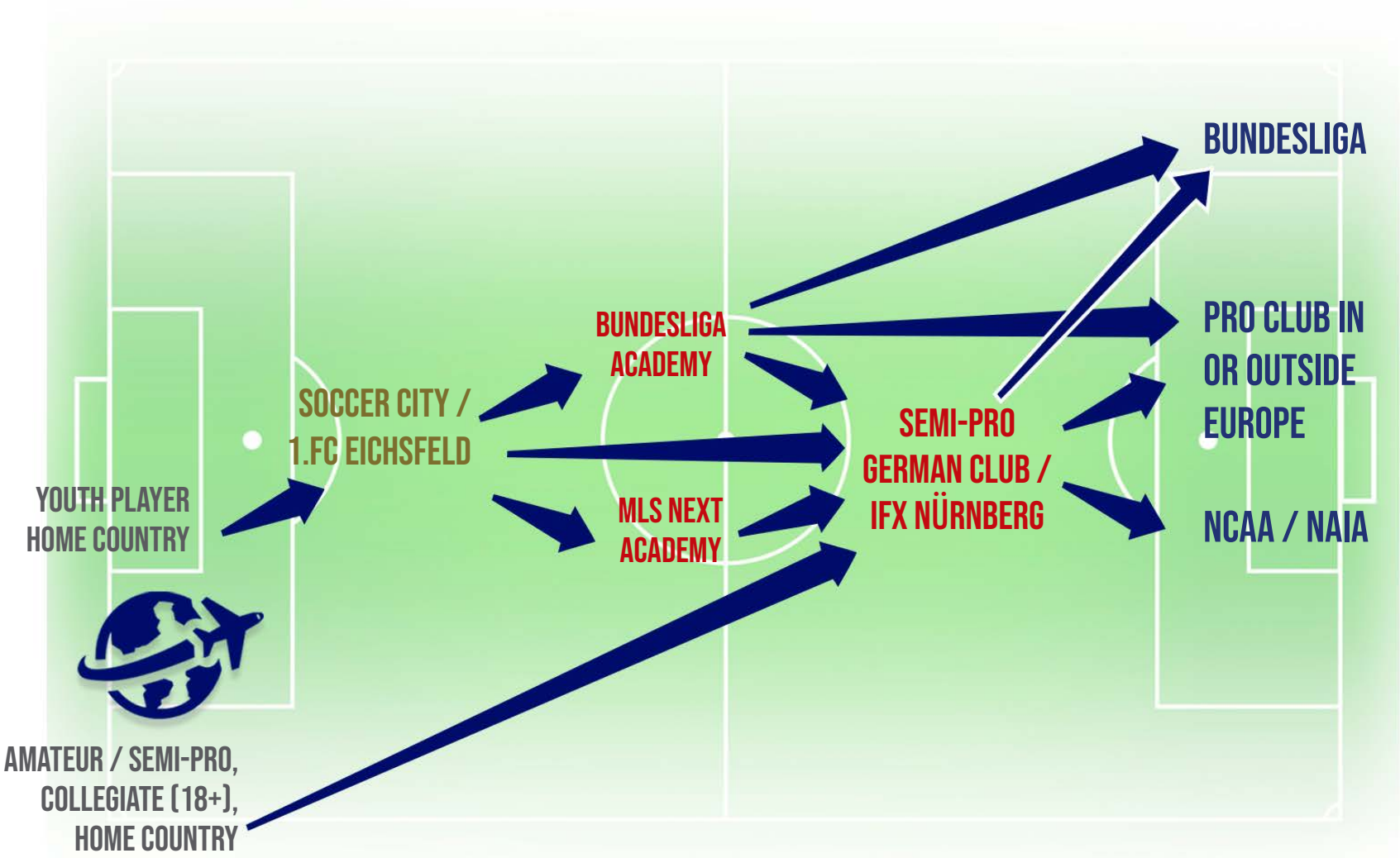

ADVANTAGES VS. US UNI ROUTE



German leagues comprised of players 18+, commonly with **former pros/more experienced players**.

Players maintain NCAA eligibility as a back up option unless they have signed a pro contract

Greater mobility during key development years. **2 transfers possible per year**. Enables player to progress upwards to more competitive levels during these formative years of their career.

Germany's **tuition-free or low-cost education** system, makes studying in Franconian, Bayern region financially feasible for many international students.

Higher level German Amateur leagues **compete in many cases against pro clubs**. In this case, high level of exposure to pro clubs and scouts.

Year-long season. Teams play **30-40 matches a year** including league competition, cup matches and friendlies.

More professional and semi-professional clubs in the German Federation than in the US



Collegiate leagues do not permit former professionals to compete, and most players are less than 23 years old, with more limited experience

Pursuing professional career in Germany after Collegiate career is very difficult since pro clubs in Germany mainly invest in younger players

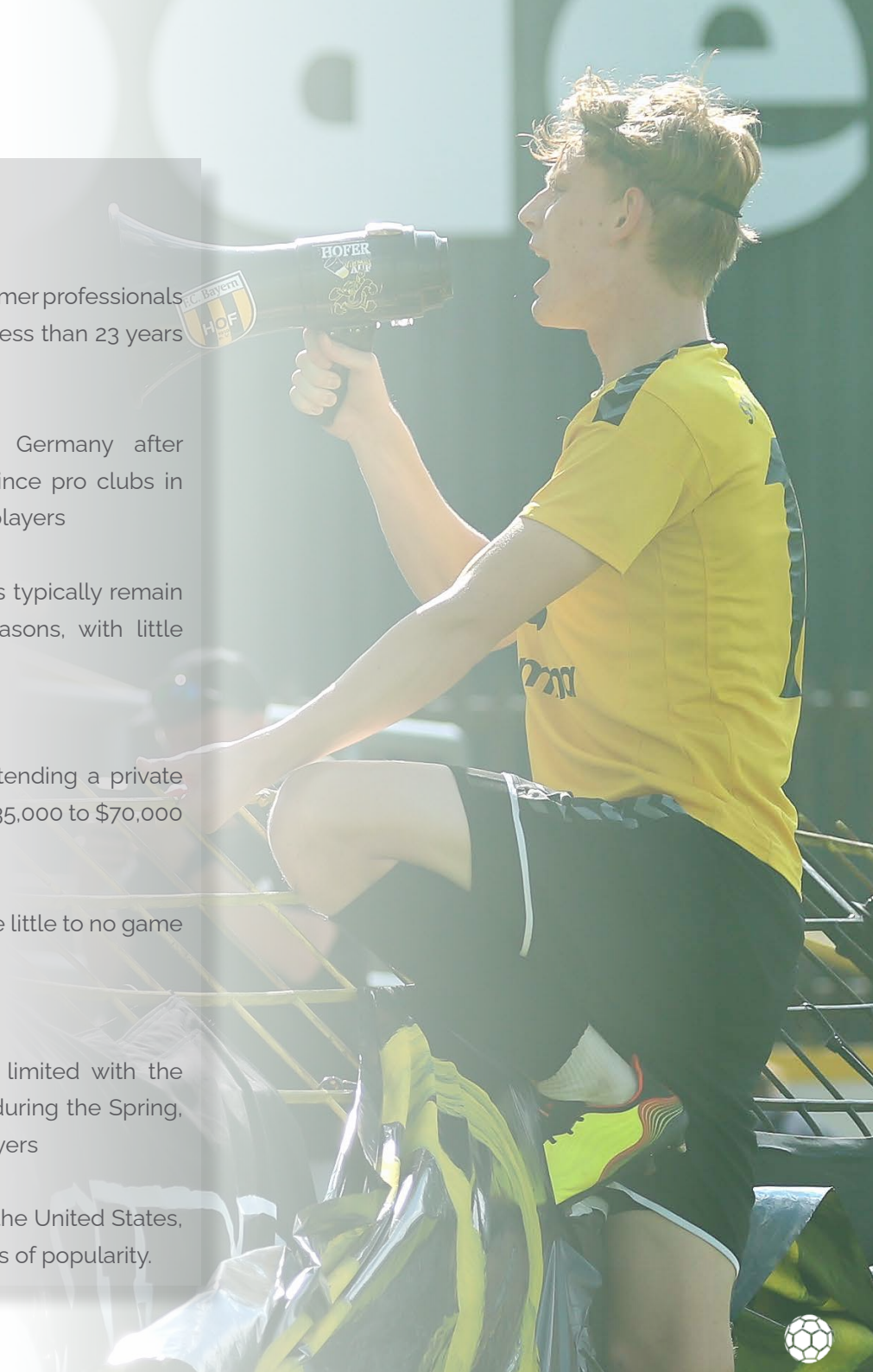
Whereas in a US University, players typically remain stagnant at their school for 4 seasons, with little mobility to play for other teams.

On average, the annual cost of attending a private four-year college can range from \$35,000 to \$70,000 or more.

Many freshman red shirt players see little to no game time

NCAA has a short season and is limited with the training and competition possible during the Spring, hampering development of the players

Soccer, while gaining popularity in the United States, is not the number one sport in terms of popularity.



IFX MANAGEMENT

Michael Carlson leads the IFX team, with over 50 years of soccer experience, as a player and agent. Carlson enjoyed a 30-year playing career, reaching the higher tier semi-professional level in Germany with Freiburger FC, competing for the reigning US National Amateur Champions Uruguay SC, collegiately for the Univ. of Colorado, and 8 seasons for Concordia SC in San Francisco.
